

WASHINGTON, DC – During a press conference on Monday, Congressman Joe Courtney announced that he will lead an economic trade mission of Connecticut companies to Israel. This is the second international trade mission the Connecticut lawmaker has spearheaded to create new economic opportunities and jobs in the state.
