

WASHINGTON, DC – Congressman Joe Courtney today applauded the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s (USDA) approval of Disaster Assistance to New London County. The county was declared eligible because it is contiguous to Rhode Island counties that were declared Primary Natural Disaster Areas as a result of Tropical Storm Irene.
