## MEMORANDUM FOR INTERESTED MEMBERS OF CONGRESS

Subj: CONTRACT AWARDED FOR LEAD YARD SUPPORT AND DEVELOPMENT STUDIES AND DESIGN EFFORTS RELATED TO VIRGINIA CLASS SUBMARINES

1. General Dynamics Electric Boat Corporation, Groton, Connecticut is awarded an \$532,921,125 cost plus fixed fee modification to previously awarded contract (N00024-20-C-2120) for Lead Yard Support and Development Studies and Design efforts related to Virginia class submarines. This contract modification includes options which, if exercised, would bring the cumulative value of the modification to \$813,720,300. Work will be performed in Groton, Connecticut and Newport News, Virginia and is expected to be completed by October 2023. Fiscal year 2022 Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy funds in the amount of \$96,759,178; fiscal year 2022 Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy funds in the amount of \$8,449,061; fiscal year 2019 Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy funds in the amount of \$2,001,990; fiscal year 2020 Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy funds in the amount of \$1,223,913; fiscal year 2017 Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy funds in the amount of \$70,000 and fiscal year 2021 Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy funds in the amount of \$70,000 are obligated at time of award, of which, \$96,759,178 will expire at the end of the fiscal year.
