I am requesting funding for the Town of Windham's water infrastructure improvement project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Windham, located at 979 Main Street in Willimantic, Connecticut 06266. Willimantic is a census-designated place within Windham, CT.

The funding would be used to replace a water main, reline a water main, and construct a new water storage tank.
